# TERMS OF AGREEMENT

From a logical point of view – therefore strictly speaking -- I cannot really know that the earth is flat if the earth is round. I might believe it to be flat but I cannot know it, for I cannot know something which is false. In similar fashion I cannot know that  $2+2=5$ , though I know full well that the statement " $2+2=5$  is false" is true. In other words, I can know of something *that* it is false, but I cannot know something false.

Fortunately, we do not need to refer to strict logical rules in order to make sense. Any attempt to do such a thing would render the coherent use of natural language virtually impossible. No doubt most of what we believe is true, and most of the time we are perfectly justified in claiming to know that it is -- even if it turns out not to be. And this of course is how we normally go about our daily lives. On the other hand, it's clear that the logical use of language cannot be totally sidelined. Without consistency of meaning and the avoidance of contradiction, discursive language really would be useless. And the inherent logic of language – language strictly used or otherwise -- is a function of our tacit agreement over the meanings and implications of the words employed.

Another necessary feature of knowledge is belief. Hence "I know the earth is round but I don't believe it is round" is an obvious contradiction. And this extra logical requirement of belief gives knowledge claims their subjectivity. But while we have some choice about what to believe, it would seem that objective truth – the way things really are -- makes demands of its own. As Bishop Joseph Butler once put it, "Everything is what it is, and not another thing". And here we have a logical truth of identity ( $x = x$ ) which looks at first as though it points to an independent reality when in fact it speaks only of our division of the world into numerous and different types of things. Given this understanding, what counts as objective truth is largely a question of human agreement within a particular culture. If a given society believes that the earth is flat, or that trees can think, or that animals have spirits, then such is their truth. We know better – or perhaps we just know *differently*. But even if the objective status of some truths is a relative matter of cultural agreement, it doesn't follow that such agreement is *merely* relative. After all, and again strictly speaking, the logic of agreement entails the freedom to disagree – hopefully in terms of language and behaviour, certainly in terms of thought.





# Psychological Support for People Experiencing Long-Covid.

We are aware that many people with long-covid are finding it difficult to access support.

As part of our service in this area we are offering group-work which can be accessed online.

Courses are initially ten sessions of 90 minutes each and offer different approaches to managing long-covid. A confidential assessment enables you to ask any questions and check what makes sense for you.

Course leaders are experienced therapists who recognise the core need for pacing, the variety of physical symptoms associated with this condition, and the potential for trauma being present. They are all experienced in helping people deal with difficult emotions and trauma reactions.

Each course will accommodate up to twelve people. If this is of interest to you, please contact us. You will be offered the initial confidential assessment within 2 weeks which will enable you to discuss payment and plan a start date.

## Course A: Hidden Strengths

*Tuesdays 6:30 – 8:00 pm (contact us for dates)*

Therapy often revolves around people's relationships and what they mean to them. We know that coping with chronic illness is easier for people who are able to maintain good relationships, not just with close family, but also with the community and, most importantly of all, with themselves. Having long-covid presents many challenges to how we see ourselves and how others see us. This course will explore how we can meet these challenges.

## Course B: Self-Care

*Wednesdays 1:30 – 3:00 pm (contact us for dates)*

We know that each person's experience of long-covid is unique, but there are also patterns which we can learn from. Because we are only just beginning to understand the challenges which long-covid entails, the real experts are the people experiencing the condition themselves. This group will help participants explore their experiences, share what has worked and what not in managing their symptoms, and think together about what it might mean for their future and that of their families. The therapists involved in each course are experienced in helping people deal with difficult emotions and trauma reactions.

## Course C: Staying Mindful

*Thursdays 10:00 – 11:30 am (contact us for dates)*

It is accepted that mindfulness can be a valuable aid in managing chronic physical and mental health conditions. With long-covid it is important that the practitioners offering support can help the client negotiate the challenges involved in looking inwards at their experience, taking from the practice what is right and needed by them. This course will introduce participants to some of the key practices that can help change the way in which they think about their condition.


### Advanced Notice
