New York, New York

I write this having just returned from the big apple. We had a good set of flights and no dramas either end. We did all the major things, we walked the Brooklyn Bridge, which, at it's opening in 1883 was the longest suspension bridge in the world. We walked through Central Park, which took an age and we had a ferry ride to see the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island. We also went to Katz Diner, which the famous Harry Met Sally scene happened, you know the one! We wandered through the old Jewish quarter and Little Italy, to mention just a few things.

Nevertheless, there was also another story that most don't think about. I asked the question how Covid has affected the City of millions of people and the answer is rather shocking. The city lost over a thousand restaurants which didn't return. People who worked in the service industry never returned, despite the fact that they had done it all, their lives. The yellow cabs are dying out. I remember watching Taxi the comedy show and that in every New York based drama, the yellow cabs were a fixture of the city's life. No more. They aren't as abundant and they are all non-American cars. The fuel economy of the old American cars just isn't as good as the Japanese cars and the fuel crisis has changed the culture in America on cars. In short, things have changed a lot.

My first clue was I noticed that going into shops the cashiers never smiled. I remember being in America years before and the one thing I remember was their over familiarity and smile. You couldn't move for a smile face. Now, no one is smiling, why? Well, it's because they are all new in the service industry and haven't been trained for it. They are all new in the job. It's amazing how things have a profound impact upon the culture of a city. No one is immune from the world beyond its borders. Having said that, I think the most poignant reminder of this was the 9/11 memorial. A place of profound sadness and yet a great sense of the sacred. A place where the presence of God is palpable, at least I thought so. Seeing the names of those who died was very intense. Nevertheless, it also makes me think about how resilient the human spirit is. Whatever the world throws at us, we move forward and we make new what was old and we move forward, just as New Yorkers have. We should never be afraid of the world beyond us, but only where we go from here.

NEWS FROM THE PARISH COUNCIL

Burghill Parish Council held its latest meeting on Tuesday 5th September 2023. Nine Councillors were present along with four members of the public.

The Three Elms North East Quarter planning application was discussed with the main issues being flooding and drainage, transport access on the Roman Road and Three Elms Road and local infrastructure. This proposed development will be an important consideration for the new Herefordshire Local Plan, which is currently on hold. A major part of this plan will be to set out policies by which planning applications will be determined, such as infrastructure, environmental issues and in addition allocation of land for housing, employment and other uses, this application has pre-empted the publication of these policies. It was agreed to object to the application.

The Parish Council's standing Commons and Environment Working Groups were discussed and it was agreed to replace them with project based working groups led by individual Parish Councillors. The Finance and Administration Working Group will continue as it is required for diligence and monitoring purposes. This will be reviewed in 12 months.

Representatives of the Parish Council recently attended a meeting at the school and the two main issues discussed were speeding by the school and the school's use of the Copse on Whitmoor Pool Common which is adjacent to the school. Parish Council led discussions with Herefordshire Council have led to the proposal for pilot scheme for a 20mph zone by the school. The use of the Copse by the school was discussed and it was agreed to move forward with a more formal agreement.

The possible need to revise our Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP) was discussed and advice will be sought from Herefordshire Council. Grants are currently available for EV Charge Points; the Clerk will ask Simpson Hall if there are interested in providing a facility. Volunteers are currently going through security checks (this will take approximately 3 months) for the Community Speed Watch and once this has

been completed, they will start their formal training. Areas in the parish initially identified as speeding hot spots will be looked at first. There are currently four vacancies, for co-opted members of the Parish Council which have been advertised on the Parish Councils website and in the Community Magazine.

Janette Pudsey has officially taken on the role of co-ordinating Burghill Talk Community Hub from the Good Neighbour Scheme. A vote of thanks was given to both Joe and Joanna Helme for all their hard work with the Burghill Talk Community Hub over the last few years. The next Good Neighbour Coffee morning will be held at the Simpson Hall on 13th October from 10:00 to 11:30 and the Community Hub volunteers will also be in attendance to provide any information that Parishioners may require. The current footpaths officer is struggling to look after the northern area of the parish so an advert will be placed in the magazine asking for volunteers to assist him in this area. The Golden Meadow Playgroup have approached the Parish Council for funds to purchase items such as craft supplies, messy play items, etc., for the children who attend. It was agreed that Joy Carroll would contact the lead of this playgroup as she knows a university nursey recently closed and they were offering all their unused stock at reasonable prices.

Our next meeting is Tuesday 14th November. We hope to see you there.

Maintaining Hedges

The Parish Council would remind residents that it is a legal duty, under the Highways Act 1980, not to obstruct the public highway without legal authority or excuse; and not to leave debris on it. The public highway is defined by law as consisting of any verge, footway, carriageway, bridleway, or footpath that is maintained at public expense and over which the public has a right of way.

This means that landowners and occupiers whose hedges run alongside the public highway are responsible for the maintenance of the hedge. Failure to adequately maintain a hedge and prevent a hedge from interfering with the use of the highway may result in a formal notice being served by the local authority requiring action.

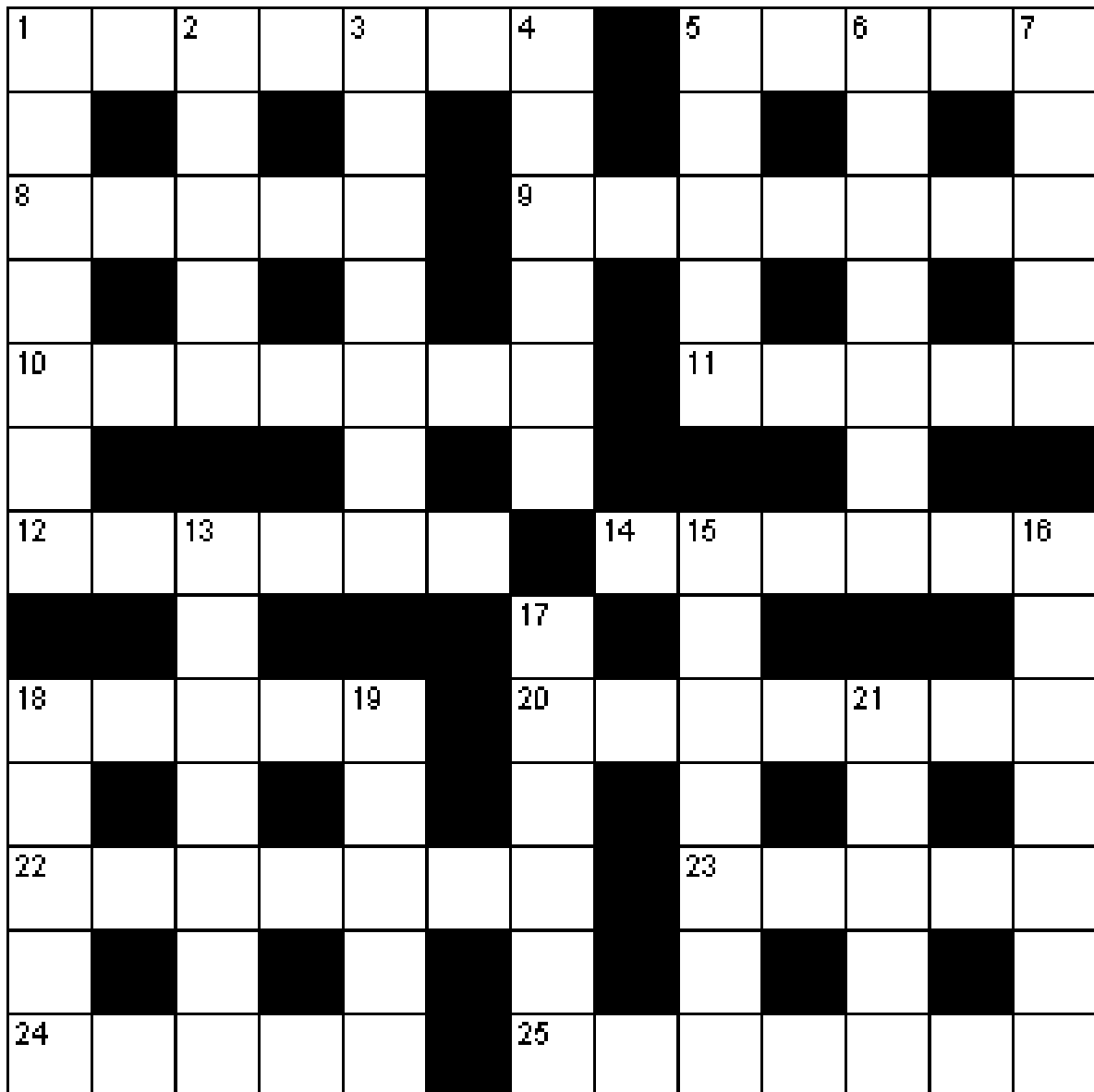
“BURGHILL IN BLOOM”

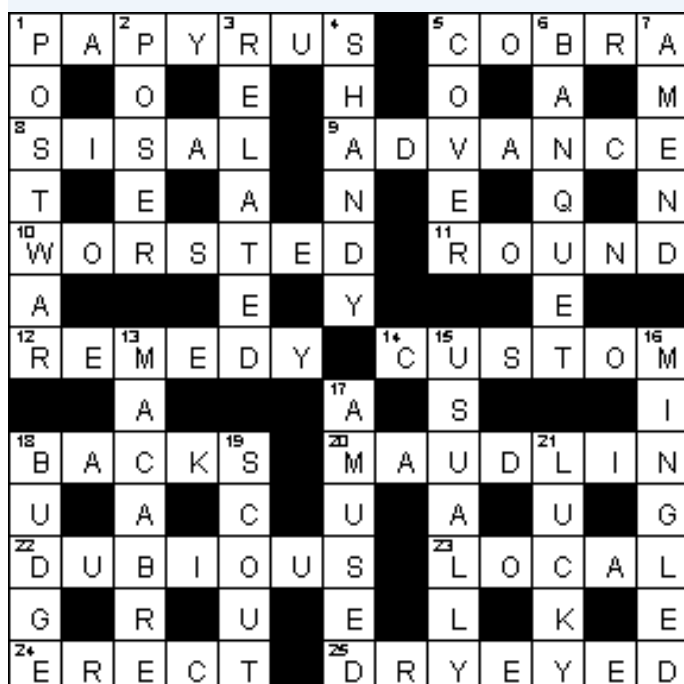

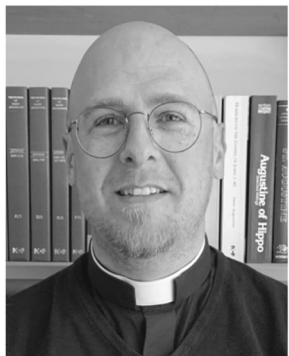
