Nevertheless, we must not be brittle about it but flexible with what it means to live in a tolerant and accepting society.

If a comedian says something that you find penetrating, don't worry about it, it'll be someone else's turn in a moment and remember that a joke is just that. If we want to be tolerated, we must be tolerating and roll with the punches. It's the only way to be.

PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

Burghill Parish Council held its latest meeting on Tuesday 10th September 2024. Five Councillors were present along with seven members of the public.

The Parish Council discussed one planning application:

1. 242006 - Building at Burlton Business Park, Burghill, HR4 7RQ. Proposed extensions of existing commercial building. It was resolved to Not Object to the application as long as the existing conditions, agreed by the applicant, apply to this Planning Application as they do for the rest of Burlton Business Park.
- ♦ Cllr Pauline Crockett, our Ward Councillor gave an update on Herefordshire Council.
 - ♦ Adam Westlake, our local PCSO gave the meeting an update on the local crime statistics.
 - ♦ Sally Robertson gave the meeting an update on The Copse and thanked the Parish Council for its recent donation towards helped to buy some new play equipment. The Trustees are seeking the support of the Parish Council for purchasing some new cabins and

for buying the playing field from Herefordshire Council. It was agreed that the Parish Council would support this and thanked Sally for all her hard work with The Copse Leisure Trust.

- ♦ The introduction of the Community Speed Watch programme has been postponed. This is due to the excessive speeds on the local roads, which makes it unsafe for volunteers to monitor speeding vehicles. The Parish Council will consider other options for managing traffic speeds and it is hoped that the Community Speed Watch programme can be introduced in the future. It is hoped that the introduction of the new 20mph speed limit and signage by the school will be completed in the next few months.
- ♦ The Neighbourhood Development Plan review was discussed. The Government is currently consulting on the National Planning Policy Framework after which Herefordshire Council will need to review the Local Plan. Only after this can the Parish Council review the Neighbourhood Development Plan. This is likely to be next year.
- ♦ Janette Pudsey reported that she had been in contact with Gerry Blyth from the Simpson Hall and Sally Robertson from CAP and planned to offer some Digital Awareness sessions. This has been raised by Talk Community as many of us now are expected to complete forms on line for example to Health Practitioner's, Government Departments etc., also, how to ensure safety when using such technology. The sessions will be held monthly, dates to be advised, at the Simpson Hall. Participants are invited to bring their own digital equipment, phones, tablets, laptops. There will be two laptops available which have been provided to Burghill Talk Hub from Hereford Community fund.
- ♦ The local library will continue to be run in the old telephone box by the church and Mr Fletcher was thanked for all his hard work and for raising over £2200 for the church.

The Parish Council currently has two vacancies which will be filled by co-option. If you are interested in becoming a Parish Councillor, please contact the Chair or Clerk.

The Parish Council are also looking for a new Footpaths Officer, if you are interested, please contact the Clerk.

Our next meeting is on Tuesday 12th November. We hope to see you there.

Bird Resistant Ornamental Berries and Fruits

Although it is good to plant fruiting and berrying plants which will feed our local wildlife, it is also rather pleasing for the gardener to be able to enjoy the sight of ornamental fruits and berries which will persist a little longer into winter. Here are some suggestions...

Red berries and fruits are normally regarded as the most tasty and attractive colour by wildlife and tend to get gobbled up first. However, the clustered red crab apples of *Malus* 'Red Sentinel' are hard and waxy, and can often last on the tree well into the New Year, eventually succumbing to frost damage and bio degrading. Another persistent red is the scarlet berried low evergreen *Gaultheria procumbens* which makes a great winter basket or tub feature, as do young plants of *Skimmia reevesiana* with their very hard red berries. In the garden, these latter shrubs can reach about 5-6 ft (1.5-1.8m.) The clustered berries of some types of 'Mountain Ash' (*Sorbus aucuparia* types) can feed the birds if you grow the red and yellow forms, yet other types with white or pink berries often remain untouched (e.g. *Sorbus hupehensis*, 'Pink Pergoda' or *Vilmorinii*), decorating the bare branches of the winter tree on pink stems long after the leaves have disappeared.

Generally white berries are much less attractive to birds so the white fruits of the Snowberries (*Symphoricarpos*) – as well as its pinky-violet berried forms – will also persist. So too will the blue flushed white berries of some of the coloured stem dogwoods (*Cornus alba* types.)

For a real steely blue, the bird resistant berries of a pollinated female plant of *Viburnum davidii* are difficult to beat and can often still be seen the following spring.

Another distinctive and eye catching shrub is *Callicarpa* 'Profusion' which bears clusters of small berries of bright violet colour on pollinated female plants. A final favourite of mine are the profuse clusters of red flushed creamyyellow berries of the prickly *Berberis wilsonii*, complemented by its autumn leaf colour. These fleshy berries are unlikely to persist until Christmas but are an autumn joy to behold.

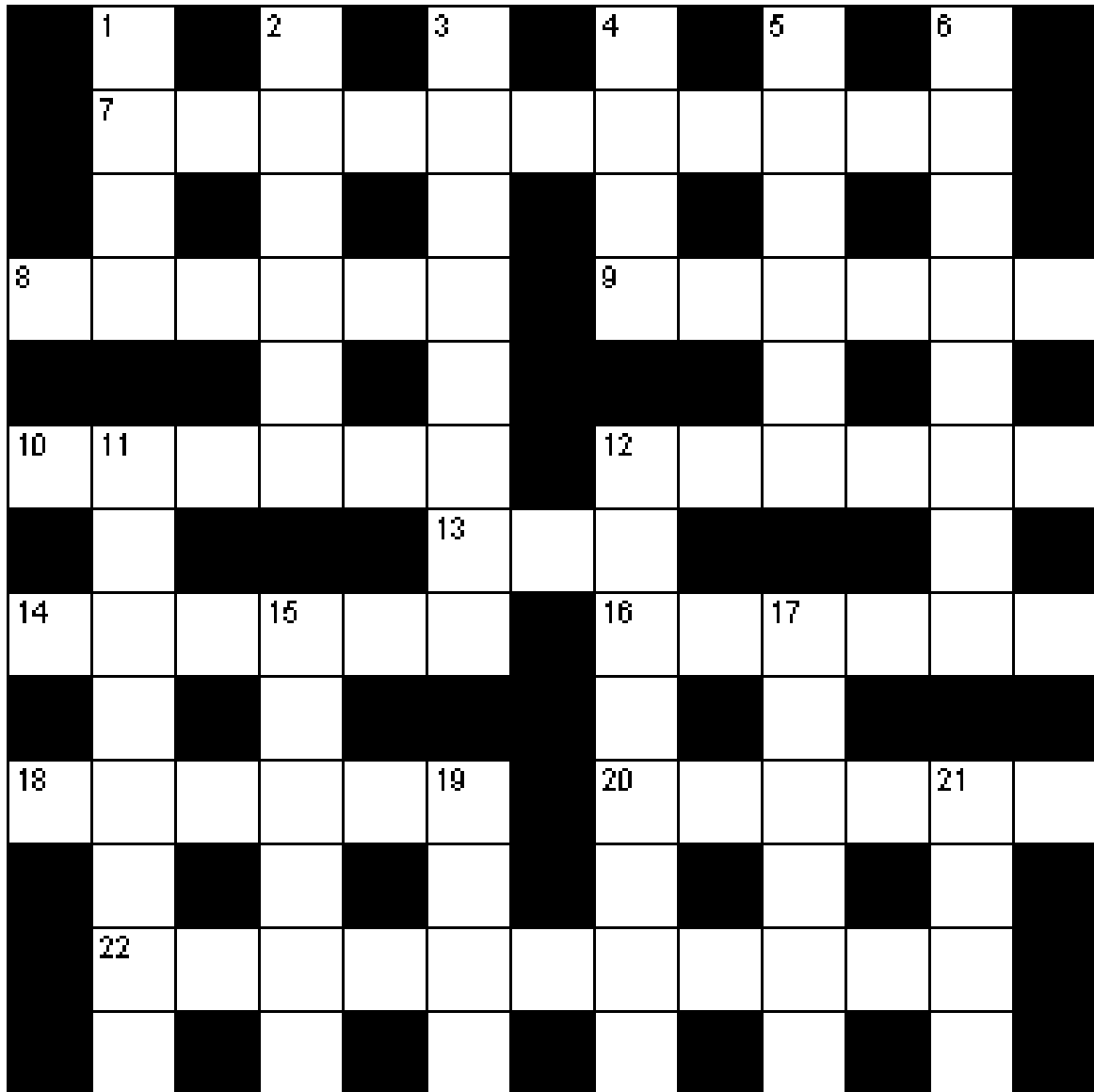
