PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

Burghill Parish Council held its latest meeting on Tuesday 14th January 2025. Twelve Councillors were present along with twelve members of the public.

The Parish Council discussed three planning applications:

- ⇒ 242818 - Woodside, Burghill, HR4 8NQ. Proposed side extension with loft conversion and internal and external alterations. It was **RESOLVED** to **NOT OBJECT** to the application.
- ⇒ 242826 - Upper House, Tillington, HR4 8LQ. Proposed change of use and conversion of agricultural buildings to residential use to create two new dwellings and alterations to existing agricultural storage barn. It was **RESOLVED** to **NOT OBJECT** to the application but the Parish Council asks that Herefordshire Council undertakes due diligence on the alternative drainage proposals for this application.
- ⇒ 243211 - Field Barn located in parcel to west of A4110, Canon Pyon, HR4 8NN. Prior approval for the proposed change of use of a part of an agricultural building and its respective curtilage to a single, larger dwelling and the building operations reasonably necessary to facilitate the change of use. This is a Class Q Permitted Development application and the Parish Council **RESOLVED TO ASK** that Herefordshire Council confirms that this planning proposal meets the criteria for a Class Q conversion.

The Council discussed joining the new Lengthsman scheme being offered by Herefordshire Council. By joining this new scheme, the Parish Council will have the opportunity to apply for more grants related to minor road maintenance and drainage. The Council agreed, in principle, to pursue the scheme.

The traffic management scheme by the local school has been delayed for various reasons including the need a road closure in school holidays and good weather. It is hoped that the scheme will be completed over the coming months.

Talk Community is going well, they have recently received laptops for use at the coffee mornings, which are well supported. They are

starting to do Digital Awareness sessions on the third Wednesday of each month, the next one is on 19th February.

A discussion took place regarding the flooding that had occurred recently. The Parish Council have now been granted a small drainage grant which will allow for certain ditches to be cleared out and other solutions are now being looked at. The Parish Council will do whatever it can to help residents affected by flooding.

The Parish Council have two vacancies, if anyone is interested, please contact the Clerk.

Our next meeting is on Tuesday 11th March. We hope to see you there.

REPF Community Infrastructure Grant

Although the weather has not been great over the last few months, we have been moving forward with improving facilities for the community to use.

Back in 2023 it was agreed that after years of repairs the play tunnel had come to the end of its life and so it was time for it to be removed and hopefully replaced. The community questionnaire that parishioners completed provided invaluable feedback and highlighted that residents felt The Copse needed more play equipment for early years children. The trustees looked at suitable equipment and it was agreed that Playdale Hong Kong was the preferred option at a cost of £14,291.03. Guidance on possible grants and completing applications was sought from Herefordshire Voluntary Organisation Support (HVOSS) and we were delighted to be awarded £10,000 from the REPF Community Infrastructure Grant/UKSPF Fund through Herefordshire Council's Community Capacity Grant and Burghill Parish Council kindly donated £2,500 towards the project too.

The tunnel was kindly removed by Dave Morris in September and the new early years play equipment was installed in October. We have seen lots of children using the new equipment and The Copse play area continues to be used on a regular basis by all age groups.

We will now turn our attention to looking at the modular buildings to replace the existing portacabins and also install a path across the car park to make the area accessible for all users. We are aware that the car park has flooded a few times during heavy rainfall due to it being a low point and run off gathers in the car park. We are hopeful drainage work will resolve this issue.

May we take this opportunity to thank you for supporting The Copse with fundraising and attending events, it is much appreciated, and we look forward to seeing you at events in the future.





Heathers are Wonderful Things...

One of the most colourful flowers around this month are the Winter Heathers, offering massed displays of pink, white or carmine flowers, regardless of the severity of the weather.

The Heathers you see blooming now are of the *Erica x darleyensis*, *Erica carnea* and *Erica erigena* types. These are tolerant of alkaline soils (such as that found here in the village) and flower sometime between December and March.

Yet the Heather family – which are basically very dwarf, evergreen shrubs - have now been bred to offer colour in most months of the year if you are able to mix various types together. For it is not only the flowers which can enrapture: some types have coloured foliage and eye-catching new leaf tips as well, which can be more stunning than the flowers themselves.

Very attractive examples of this would be the coloured spring tips of the 'Scotch Heather' - *Calluna* types (which will need acid, or at least neutral, soils) such as 'Irish Orange', 'Flamingo' and 'Wickwar Flame'. Golden coloured foliage, with a slight bronzing in winter, is also available in one or two *Erica carnea* Heathers (and these will tolerate some soil alkalinity).

Autumn will never be without colour either, with a range of early autumn flowering *Calluna* Heathers available and some acid-loving summer types persisting into September, such as the 'Dorset heaths' (*Erica ciliaris*), the 'Irish Heath' (the *Daboecia* family) and the grey-leaved 'Bog Heath' (*Erica tetralix*), which, as its common name suggests, prefers it damp.

Other Heathers bloom in summer: *Erica vagans* types ('The Cornish Heath') have short, beady flower spikes in pinks or white and also tolerate alkalinity.

With their evergreen foliage, small size, bright colours and low growing habit, Heathers have a huge number of uses in the garden: as ground cover, in patio tubs, hanging baskets and at the front of a border. Care is straightforward – water until new plants are established (and always if confined in a container), feed with a granular ericaceous fertiliser in spring and give your plants a moderately strict 'hair cut' in spring to keep them in a good, rounded shape. Avoid cutting back hard into old wood, though, or they may not regrow.






