## **Tips on Creating Your Own Summer Hanging Baskets**

By the end of May it is usually possible to put summer hanging baskets outdoors safely. From now until then it is time to plant them up and grow them on under glass. Here are some tips:

- Choose as large a basket or container as you can as the greater the volume of compost, the easier it will be to look after with regard to watering and feeding, and the more tolerant it will be of extreme temperatures.
- A wire hanging basket will need a liner to retain the compost. The most efficient liners are those which are plastic lined but porous, or moulded pulp. Moss or coconut fibre are poor retainers of moisture as well as being ecologically unsound.
- Use new compost every year and mix in slow release fertiliser (e.g. the Miracle Gro mini balls.) These will feed for the entire season. The alternative is to apply liquid fertiliser every fortnight.
- Mix in moisture-retaining granules (e.g. 'Swell Gel'). These are definitely not a substitute for water itself but they will retain the water you give the basket or tub for longer.
- Before you shop for plants, consider which ones will be suitable for the position where you intend to put them. There are summer bedding plants which like shade and others which will thrive only in hot sun.
- Consider your colour combinations – do you want a colour theme?
- Next, mentally divide your plants into three categories: upright feature plants for the centre (e.g. Geraniums or Cordylines), trailing plants to hang over the edge (e.g. Nepeta), and then plants which form low clumps (e.g. Lobelia or Nemesia.) These latter are to fill in around the feature and trailing plants,
- Plant the trailing plants around the sides and, if the basket is designed to plant underneath, on the undersides too .
- Plant the upright feature plant(s) in a slightly off centre position on the top to avoid the hanging basket chains.
- Then fill in the remaining areas with the clump-forming plants. Bear in mind that summer bedding plants will expand in size quite dramatically over the next couple of months, so anticipate this with your spacing.
- Water regularly, trying not to allow the basket to dry out completely. Even if the plants survive drought, growth will be checked and they may sustain some cosmetic damage.
- If you have a number of baskets in close proximity, an automatic drip watering system from an outdoor tap, using a timer, is a very good investment.

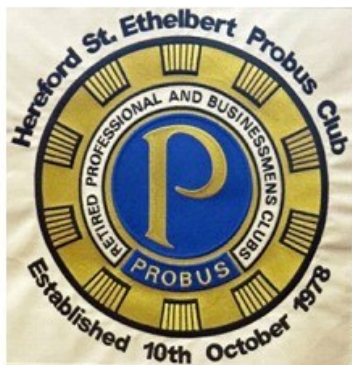

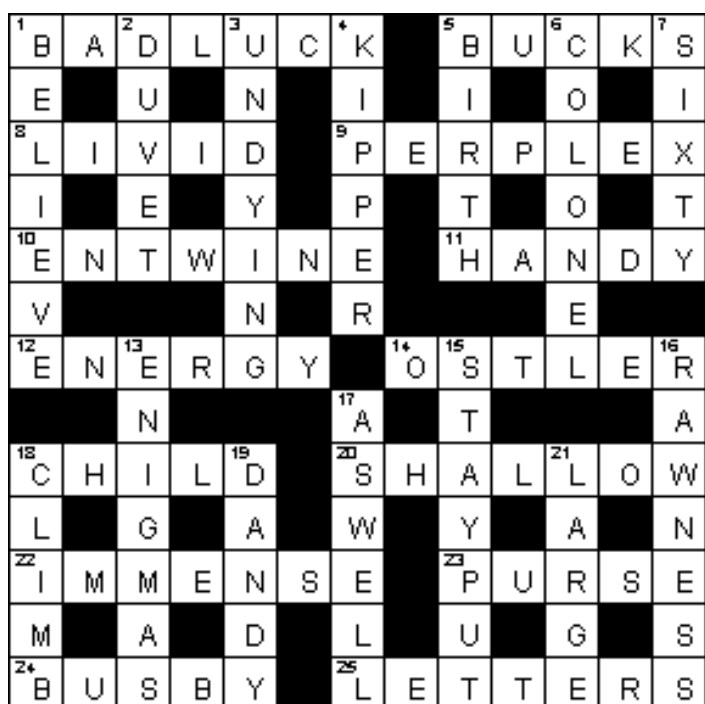

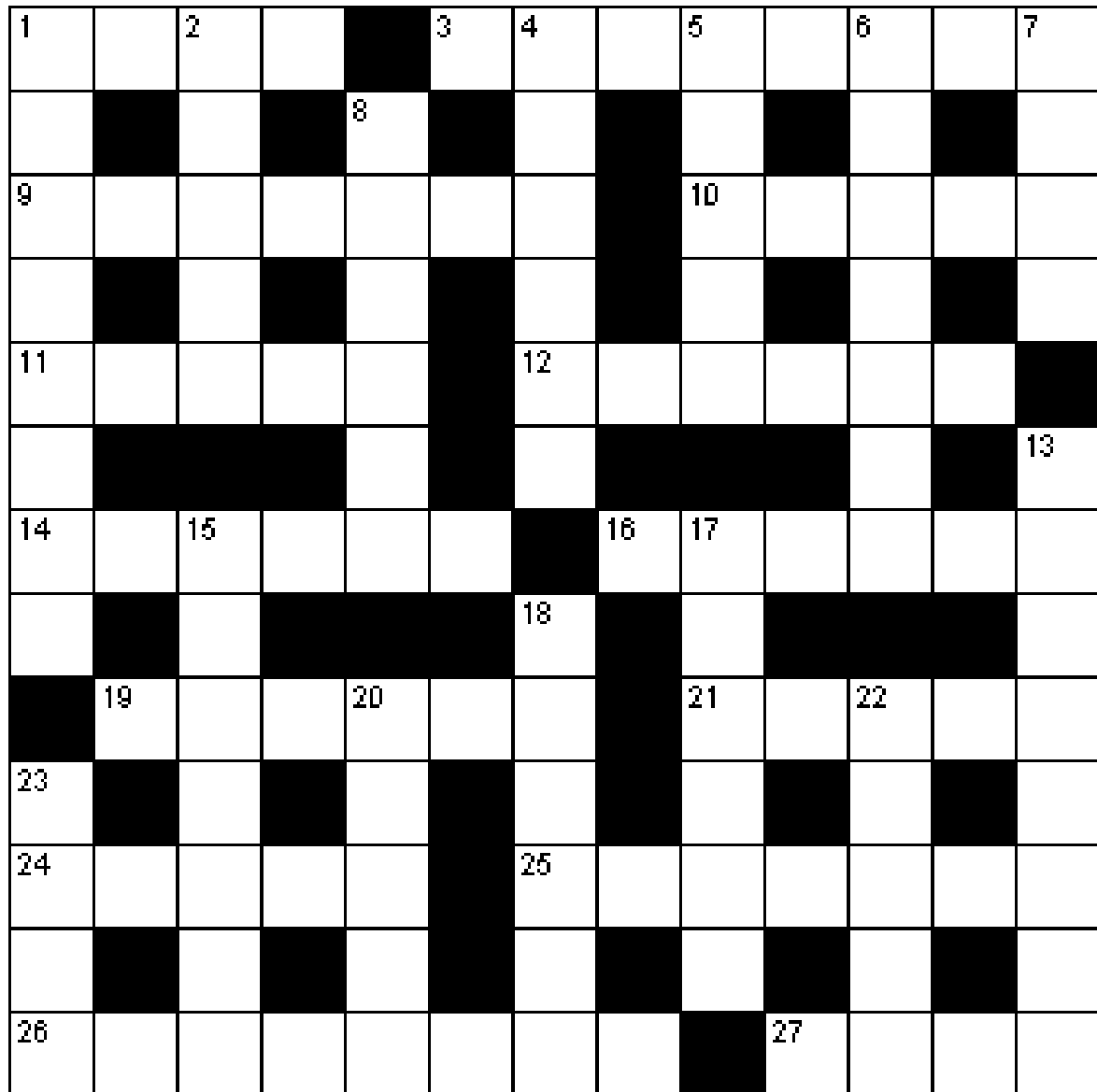
