## Dialogue, Not Denigration.

I heard some say recently that there are two kinds of personal criticisms. One, is a suggestion, by someone you love and respect that you should perhaps change something, what you think, what you have said or even perhaps something you wear. It could be anything. The aim of such criticism is an attempt to get you to improve upon yourself. It comes from a place of loving concern, which is good. The other kind, is simply to undermine, diminish and control you. This is about control, not loving concern and it comes from a place that does not try to build you up, but rather tear you down. We have all come across this kind of treatment at some point in our lives. I think this question, 'is this coming from a loving place or an unloving place?', drive our hesitancy in accepting other people's advice, because sometimes we can't tell where it is coming from. At the end of the day, human beings struggle with figuring out the intent of the other.

I am currently thinking about this question in terms of international affairs, and how different groups can approach each other with this in mind. Sometimes the intent is clear and other times not so obvious. I recently heard that the average age of someone inducted into the Mexican Cartel is twelve or thirteen. At that age, they simple do not know that what they are being introduced to is evil. I'm sure poverty plays a massive part, but it is very difficult at that age to figure out, with all the flashy incentives, that they are not what the Cartel value. I also think about those living in Ukraine and other war-torn places, how the demonization and the hatred between the waring parties, influences peoples, opinions of those belonging to a different group. I think at present and most obviously is the conflict in Gaza. Two people who are so beset against each other, who have inflicted upon each other such horrendous things, through the years. The great Plato said, 'the first casualty of war is the truth'. Once truth perishes, goodness fades and love run dry. So what hope is there?

It comes back to a simple choice. Do you want what is good for others or are you simply concerned for yourself? Tearing others down or even apart is evil. Because it fails to see them as fellow human beings with an equal dignity and value to that of yourself. The world is full of pain and suffering, but to give in to it is to surrender to it. To lose sight of the value of other is to lose yourself. Denigrating those not off you or who are different from you does no good. Talking and understanding does. So let's talk.




## REV PHILL'S FIFTY FUND-RAISING ABSEIL

## The Ever Delightful Lavender

With their wafting fragrance, long flowering period and magnetic effect on bees and butterflies, the Lavenders are one of the most perfect of the English cottage garden plants.

There are many different species of Lavender. Some, like the so-called '**Spanish Lavender**', with its serrated leaves, or the '**French Lavender**' (*Lavandula stoechas* types) are unlikely to survive a British winter outside in this area and are best regarded as summer only features.

However, there are others which are perfectly hardy here provided their basic cultural needs are met. These are: a well drained soil even in winter (make a raised bed to avoid Hereford clay), lots of sunshine, correct pruning and shelter from winter winds.

**The 'English Lavenders'** (*Lavandula angustifolia* types) are the most popular and have upright flower spikes, carried on long stems above the foliage layer throughout the summer months, commonly in shades of blue or purple and sweetly fragrant with the familiar lavender perfume. There are also smart pink and white flowered forms.

Like all traditional cottage garden plants, this lavender was originally grown not so much for its beauty as for its domestic usefulness. We know that Lavender was being used in bathwater for its cleansing and therapeutic properties back in Roman times. It has been made into a natural disinfectant - immensely popular during the plague, based on the verity that its juice can kill a whole range of common bacteria. Lavender has also been used as a compress to treat burns and acne, for its calming effect on insomniacs, and has been (and still is) placed in drawers and wardrobes in dried form to repel moths and other insects.

A taller variation of the English type, with similar flowers and scent, is the '**Dutch Lavender**' (*Lavandula 'Vera'*). '*Vera*' is a vigorous and tall growing type which can be used to make an impressive hedge up to about 5 feet (1.5m) in height. Although the English Lavenders too can make delightful low hedges of about 2 feet (60cms), '*Vera*' is the one for impressive barriers.

All Lavenders will need pruning to maintain a compact shape and stop them getting too 'woody'. This is done twice a year. In April, give the bush a reasonably hard cut back by about two thirds, following this with a feed to encourage thick new growth. By July- August, the profusion of flower spikes will have drawn the bush upwards and it will be losing its earlier compact shape. So, ignoring any flowers (they will return later), give it another, less severe 'haircut' by a quarter to one third. The bush will then regrow a compact shape again ready to resist winter breakages from wind or snow.


## Digital Awareness Sessions


