# Lent: The Only Season Where Chocolate Becomes a Spiritual Battlefield...

Lent arrives every year with impressive punctuality and zero concern for your personal plans. One minute it's Ordinary Time; the next, someone is marking your forehead with ash while reminding you that you are dust—and also, apparently, not allowed to enjoy snacks.

For the uninitiated, Lent is a 40-day period of prayer, fasting, and self-denial. For everyone else, it is a 40-day negotiation with God that begins boldly (“I will give up all sweets, social media, and unnecessary complaining”) and ends humbly (“I will give up... one specific type of biscuit, except on stressful days”).

The trouble begins with the Great Lenten Question: What are you giving up? This question is asked everywhere—church doors, office kitchens, family group chats—and your answer will be silently evaluated. Give up chocolate and you earn respectful nods. Give up gluten and people look confused. Give up “negativity” and everyone knows you’ve found the theological equivalent of a loophole.

Of course, Lent isn't only about giving things up; you can also take things on. This sounds noble until you realise it usually means waking up earlier or praying daily. These commitments feel inspiring at 9 p.m. on Shrove Tuesday and deeply unreasonable at 6 a.m. on the first Thursday of Lent.

Then there is fasting. Fasting teaches many spiritual lessons, including the fact that you never knew how much you loved food until you were told not to think about it. Suddenly every advert features burgers, and someone in your workplace will inevitably bring cake.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday add extra complexity. The phrase “one full meal” becomes a theological puzzle, and “simple food” is interpreted with impressive creativity. Soup is analysed. Bread is weighed. Consciences are consulted—and occasionally ignored.

By the halfway point, enthusiasm fades. Prayer routines wobble. Sacrifices are accidentally broken, then deliberately broken, then deeply regretted. You consider starting Lent again “properly” on Monday, a strategy with a proven record of failure.

And yet, somehow, Lent works. Beneath the hunger and mild irritability, something shifts. You become more aware of your habits and your tendency to reach for comfort instead of reflection. By Easter, you are tired, slightly proud, and very ready for chocolate. The Alleluias sound better—and you promise yourself that next year you'll choose an easier penance.

You won't. But that's Lent.

# PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES



The Parish Council met on Tuesday 13th January. There were thirteen councillors present and ten members of the public. Our Herefordshire Council Ward Councillor, Mrs Pauline Crocket was in attendance, as was our PCSO Adam Westlake. As always, our Clerk, Mrs Paulette Scholes ensured that the meeting was conducted effectively and in accordance with the various governance requirements expected of a local authority.

After welcoming those present and receiving apologies, we started with a public participation session, whereby local residents and stakeholders can brief us, raise issues and ask questions.

We firstly received an update from Cllr Crockett about Herefordshire Council's activities that might affect the Parish. These included an update on the 2026/27 Council Tax increase, Ofsted's confirmation of the significant improvement in Herefordshire's children's services and local traffic management.

We then opened the floor to local residents so that they could raise issues of interest or concern. We always listen carefully to these and do our best to respond. It is often the case that resolution sits outside of the Parish Council. In these cases, we do our best to raise the issue with the appropriate organisation. Issues raised included inappropriate parking at Redstone and tree planting on Tillington Common. Our tree surgeon will be asked to inspect the existing trees and advise on additional trees. Adam Westlake our PCSO gave an update on various issues of concern including a road traffic accident, speeding and an alleged garden intruder.

It was confirmed that a Community Speed Watch programme will be up and running in the near future. We are currently looking for volunteers, please see the article in this edition of the Community Magazine for further details.

We discussed three Planning Applications. These are always determined by Herefordshire Council but we are consulted and respond reflecting local views. Herefordshire Council doesn't always agree with our views but we do influence the decisions made. Our detailed responses are always recorded in our minutes.

We have received a drainage grant from Herefordshire Council. The Parish Council agreed to look at how this would be spent by the end of March.

The Parish Council has received some flooding equipment, mostly flood-bags which are inflatable 'sand-bags' which expand on contact with water. However, there are not enough for all potentially affected properties. An article in this edition of the Community Magazine provides further details.

Our long-standing Clerk, Mrs Scholes sadly retires at the end of March and we are currently advertising for a replacement via the Herefordshire Association of Local Council's website (HALC).

Our next meeting is on Tuesday, 10th March, 2026, 7.00pm. Please do come along and observe and / or make a contribution. The Parish Council currently has two vacancies, if you are interested in joining us and helping to make a difference locally, then please contact our Clerk (details on our website).

Detailed minutes of our discussions and decisions are always available on our website as soon as possible after our meeting.

## The delightful winter flowering ‘Moth Orchid’

Orchids are often overlooked by the amateur, who tends to think of them as touchy pedigree specimen plants for the skilled connoisseur only. Although this may be true of some exotic species, the Phalaenopsis, or ‘Moth Orchid’ types are amongst the easiest long flowering houseplants. What’s more, they are winter flowering.

Moth Orchids have a flat, vaguely Narcissus-shaped, flower. These are borne on a smooth upright stem rising up above a rosette of thick basal leaves at soil level. Several buds on each stem will open progressively and, in a suitably cool room, each bloom can remain fresh on the plant for over a month, which means an extended winter flower display.

Colours include various combinations of pure white, hot pink, burgundy, rose-purple or yellow, many veined or patterned for extra appeal.

In the wild, Moth Orchids come from the warmer regions of Asia and grow on tree trunks and branches, where light levels are fairly low beneath the leaf canopy; this makes them adaptable to the centrally heated home here. Thus for best results, choose a light position in your house, out of direct sunlight and not shut behind window curtains at night.

The best temperature range is between 60 degrees F and 86 degrees F or 16-30 degrees C. Water as required but never allow the plant to get aridly dry for any length of time, nor stand it in water or water it in cold conditions.

Research has shown that the aerial roots of these plants thrive better with some light, so you will see many of these orchids sold in see-through pots rather than in black ones. They are best kept slightly pot bound but when you do need to pot them up, try to use a similar type of pot, just a little larger, and always use the special bark-based compost sold for this type of plant.

After flowering is finally over in spring, cut the old stem off at the base and start a feeding programme of Orchid fertiliser so that the plant rewards you with another grand winter show next year.






